1 Inventory.

Could you produce, today, a list of every app and flow in your tenant — with a named owner for each?

16–20 • Governed. You're ahead of most estates. Keep the rhythm: re-run the inventory quarterly, and hold new builds to the same bar (our published Ø Standard is built for exactly that).

9–15 · Drifting. Value is being created faster than ownership. Fix in this order: (1) inventory with owners, (2) personal credentials off critical flows, (3) environments and DLP. Those three remove most of the 2 a.m. risk.

0–8 · Ungoverned. You're carrying risk you can't see — and the honest move is to measure before something forces it. Don't start with policy documents; start with knowing what exists.
